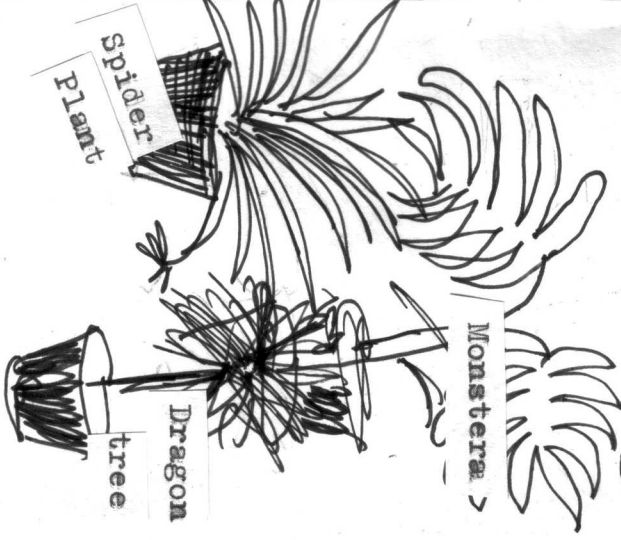

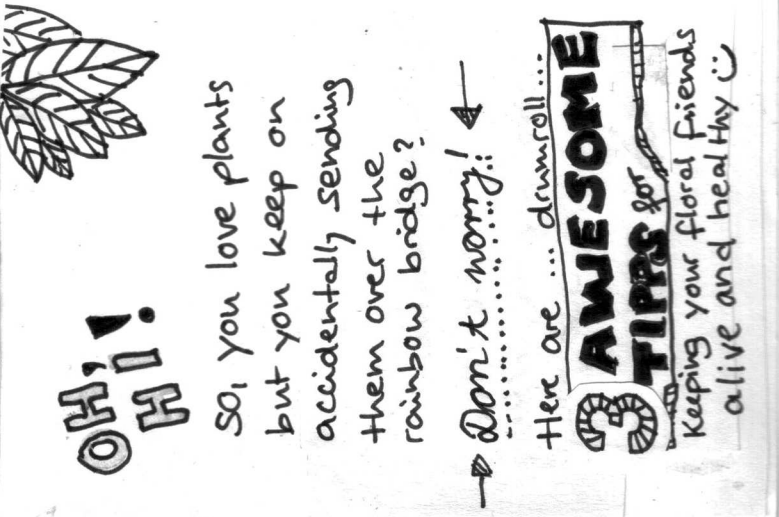

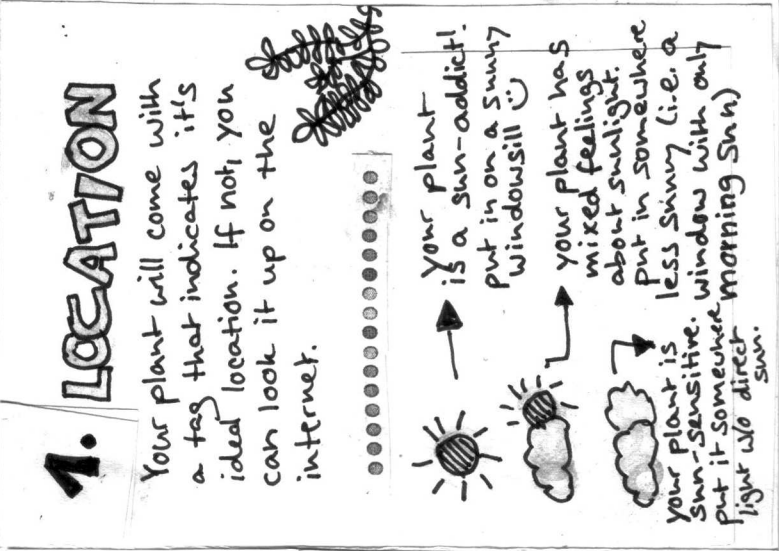
So, you love plants but you keep on accidentally sending them over the rainbow bridge?

AWESOME TIPS

Keeping your floral friends alive and healthy ☺



1. LOCATION

Your plant will come with a tag that indicates it's ideal location. If not, you can look it up on the internet.

- Your plant is a sun-addict! put in on a sunny windowsill ☺
- your plant has mixed feelings about sunlight. put in somewhere less sunny (i.e. a sun-sensitive window with only light no direct sun)

3. SIGNS OF DISCOMFORT...



BROWN LEAVES
.....
→ your plant is probably in a spot that's too sunny.



Mold on soil
.....
→ your floral friend might just have a bit too much water. exchange the soil and try to go easier on watering.

2. CHECK IN

the tag will also indicate how much water your plant needs. Check in every few days to see if your plant needs something:



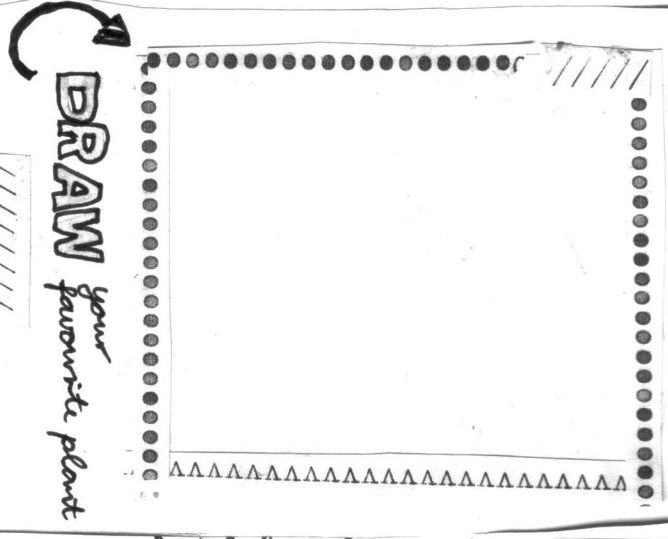
→ your plant doesn't like dryness. Give it a sip of water every day



→ a bit of water every few days will be fine



→ let your plant's soil get dry before watering
